

Call Logging Unit Replacement

There are several things to be changed when replacing a PC based Call Logging Unit. Step 4 is the most important, as there will be no remote access (ie polling) if the password does not match.

1. Login to the replacement CLP as "root"	
2. Set the time and date	eg "date mmddhhmm[yy]"
3. Edit host name with vi in /etc/HOSTNAME	eg "vi /etc/HOSTNAME"
4. Change password for clp user	eg "passwd clp" (get from telmax21/usr/lib/uucp/Systems)
5. Check the files /etc/hosts & /etc/hosts.equiv are setup	
6. Check the speed setting of the PABX port is correct	eg "vi /u/catcom/bin/dopak" then check "stty" line.
7. Reboot system and test for call logging.
